

**Minutes of the 1ST Affiliation Committee Meeting held on 03.09.2014 at 10.30 A.M in
the Chamber of Commissioner and Director of School Education,
Telangana, Hyderabad.**

Prior to the date of Re-organization of Andhra Pradesh, the Chairperson and Commissioner and Director of School Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad has issued a notification dated: 15-05-2014 calling the renewal of affiliation applications through online from the Private D.Ed. Colleges as provided in G.O.Ms.No.18 School Education (PE-PROG.II) Dated:14-05-2014 and published the notification in the reputed daily news papers in the state. The Private D.Ed. Colleges of Telangana Region have submitted the renewal of affiliation proposals through online duly uploading the necessary documents as desired. 239 online applications have been downloaded. As per the SRC, NCTE, Bangalore (20) Fresh proposals of the Private D.Ed. Colleges are received for Fresh Affiliation for the academic year 2014-2015. All the applications and documents were verified by the team of Professors and Lecturers belonging to S.C.E.R.T., TS. As per the verification report submitted by the team of Professors and Lecturers, the following are the results of the verification reports of (238) existing D.Ed. Colleges and (20) Fresh D.Ed. Colleges.

1. 39 Colleges having fulfilled all the Norms and Standards – 2009 of the NCTE. The Committee is of the opinion that for all these Colleges which have fulfilled all the conditions laid down in the NCTE Norms, may be given affiliation for a period of one year only, since there is likely hood of changing the N.C.T.E. Norms next year (Annexure – I).
2. Private D.Ed. Colleges are having deficiencies either relating to Land Area, Built up area, NOC of the District Fire Officer concerned, Staffing pattern, Library and 'or' other infrastructure and instructional facilities. These colleges are shown in Annexure – II.
3. In so far as these 199 colleges where the deficiencies are noticed, the committee is of the opinion that these colleges may be allowed to continue temporarily for the year 2014-2015, subject to the condition that, such managements shall be given notice for rectification of the defects in a specified period. In case of their failure to rectify the defects in a stipulated time, they shall be liable for with-drawl of recognition and all such D.Ed. Colleges shall not be allowed to participate in the admission counselling for the academic year 2015-16.
4. 20 New D.Ed. Colleges have also applied for grant of fresh affiliation, for the academic year 2014-2015, who have got recognition from SRC, NCTE, Bangalore. On verification of the documents submitted by the inspection team, the Committee is of the opinion that they may be granted affiliation for a period of one year only. The list of these colleges are shown in Annexure – III.

5. One existing Private D.Ed. College has applied for additional in-take of 50 students in addition to the existing permitted strength of 50 students. On verification of the proposal of the D.Ed. College, the committee is of the opinion that the college have fulfilled all the existing norms of the NCTE and recommended for additional in take of 50 students for the academic year 2014-15. The particulars of this college are shown in Annexure – IV.
6. In respect 29 Colleges, the Commissioner, School Education, Andhra Pradesh has sent the proposals to the Regional Director, NCTE Bangalore for withdrawal of recognition for violation of the admission rules. As the N.C.T.E., has already issued show cause notices to the above 29 D.Ed. Colleges. Thus the committee decided to recommend the temporary affiliation for the academic year 2014-15 only, subject to the final outcome of the orders of the SRC, N.C.T.E, Bangalore. In so far as the withdrawal of recognition, the final orders are not yet received, Government may consider to grant of affiliation for a period of one year 'or' withdrawal of affiliation by the N.C.T.E., whichever is earlier. However, the candidates who participating in the admission counselling may be advised through public notification i.e., through the SCERT Website accordingly. The list of (29) Colleges are shown in Annexure – V and these college particulars are also furnished in the list shown in Annexure – II, as they were also to be having certain other deficiencies.
7. All the documents submitted by the managements of the Private D.Ed. Colleges relating to the Land Area, Built up area, Staffing pattern, Library and Laboratory and other infrastructure and instructional facilities will be published in the public domain i.e., in the S.C.E.R.T. Website through a public notification. All the candidates will be advised to go through the Website for the facilities provided by the Colleges concerned before participating in the admission counselling.
